Boys & Girls Club of the Smoky Mountains Nutrition Program

Beginning June 8, Boys & Girls Club of the Smoky Mountains in partnership with the Sevier County Public Library System, and Anna Porter Library will provide FREE breakfast and lunches to any child in the county ages 2-18. Children do not have to be members of the Boys & Girls Club to participate. The meals may be eaten on site or “grab and go.” Parents may drive up to site and call the phone number on door of meal site for meal pickup. The Sevier County Public Library Branch Systems of Kodak, and Seymour are included in this program, as well as all five branches of the Boys and Girls Club, and the Gatlinburg Library. Senior Meals

The Sevier County Office on Aging offers mobile meals to homebound seniors over 60 years of age. The cost is on a sliding scale based on the individual’s income. Douglas-Cherokee Meals on Wheels
